Request It: Purpose and Goals



- Design a patron driven acquisitions model that encourages patron participation through a meaningful collaborative selection process
- Engage Collection Development, Discovery Services, and Acquisitions in a responsive, informed, cost effective, and streamlined approach to developing the collection
- Provide more equitable distribution of access and services, expand diverse collections, and increase insight into community interests

Request It: Suite of Services



Potential Purchasing

- We add discoverable and holdable catalog records for unowned titles
- Patrons discover and place holds on titles before we buy them

Suggest for Purchase

- We use BiblioSuggest for patron suggestion for purchase
- Patrons request titles through their online patron user account

Interlibrary Loan

- We provide a traditional ILL model
- Patrons use ILL as a last means of acquisitions

Request It: A New Perspective

- Relevant and appropriate titles supplied by vendor
- Carts prioritized using collection development identified parameters
- Factors are low demand, debut authors, sufficient subject coverage, etc.
- Order 3 months prepub





- Working with vendors to streamline workflow







Freegal - Digital Music

Hoopla – Digital eBooks, Audiobooks, Music, Movies, TV, and Comics

Kanopy - Digital Movies and TV

OverDrive - Digital eBooks and Audiobooks

Note that we may not be able to purchase all requests. Items usually arrive at within 2-16 weeks of the initial request. Note: We do not process rush requests, nor can we guarantee how long it will take to receive an item. 





Suggest for Purchase: Responsive and Efficient










Suggest for Purchase: Adding to the Collection CON'23





- Returned items automatically are routed to Collection Development
- Collection Development reviews for collection
- Cataloging provides full cataloging and processing for added items
- Items not added are shadowed in catalog and remain on Request It shelves for future requests
- After designated period, items changed to DISCARD and sent to a deaccession outlet


Suggest for Purchase: Digital and Media

Request It: Successful Outcomes



Potential Purchasing

- Increased catalog holdings
- Decreased selection time

Interlibrary Loan

- Reallocated one full-time staff
- Reduced average cost per use

Suggest for Purchase

- Increased requests
- Increased unique users
- Reduced turnaround time
- Reduced staff time
- Allowed for seamless checkout and renewal

Request It: Conclusion



- Provides a positive patron experience
- Reduces internal costs and staff time
- Fosters a robust community-informed collection
